

Directions to Barnet Medieval Festival

Barnet Elizabethans RFC is at the far end of Byng Road, Barnet EN5 4NP.

BUS

384 to junction of Alston Road & Wentworth Road (hail & ride section); c.8 min walk

107/263/307/614 to Black Horse Pub roundabout; c. 10 min walk

234/326/383/614 to back entrance of Spires; c.12 min walk (383 & 614 not on Sundays)

TRAIN & TUBE

High Barnet Station (Northern line) – 107, 234, 263, 307, 326, 384 & 614 all stop opposite station on Barnet Hill (turn left out of station); or c. 20 min walk (turn left out of station up slope & continue to top of Barnet Hill, then follow the map to Byng Rd

New Barnet Station – 107, 383, 384 outside station

CAR

Very limited car parking onsite: (suggested donation) in Christ Church School field, some disabled parking.

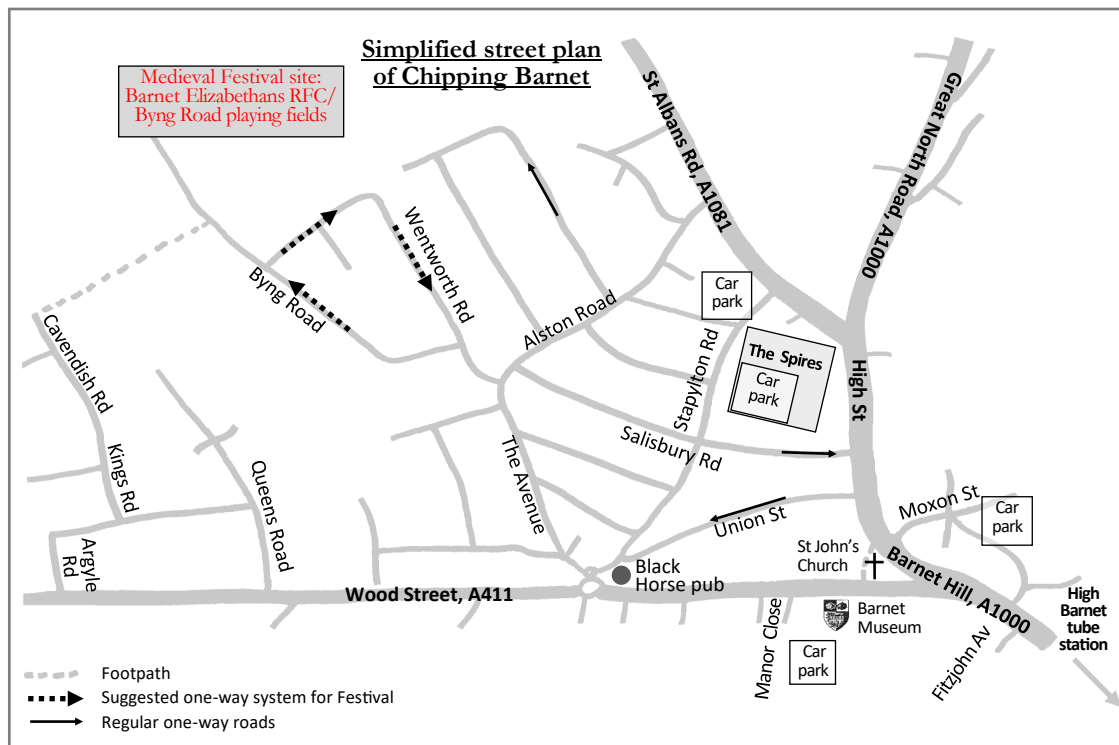
Car parks: Stapylton Road car park (pay by phone); The Spires shopping centre (Stapylton Road entrance; Sat 8-8.30; Sun 9-4.30); Moxon Street (pay by phone); Manor Close (very small, opening times vary, closes at dusk).

Local streets are narrow: one-way system in operation in Byng Rd & Wentworth Rd and there is a width restriction in Alston Road.

Byng Road is c. 10 minutes drive from **M25/A1 (M) junction at South Mimms** (M25 junction 23, A1M junction 1); take A1081 (St Albans Road) to Barnet.

No access for coaches

Please note: the festival site includes Byng Road playing fields, which will be closed to all but festival visitors during opening hours, 10.30am to 5pm.



What's on at the Medieval Festival

A full programme of displays, music, talks and activities including

- 12.00pm** Official opening with cannon fire (*Saturday*)
- 12.00pm** Battle drill practice (*Saturday*); re-enactment of the Battle of Tewkesbury (*Sunday*)
- 1.30pm** Archery demonstration
- 2.30pm** Medieval firepower display
- 4.00pm** Re-enactment of the Battle of Barnet

There will be some loud cannon fire during the displays. Dog-owners are advised to keep their dogs on a lead. Limited seating on site but folding chairs and picnic blankets are welcome.
